# Return to School w/c 1/09/20

Please note that the LA and all LAs regionally have set aside the <u>Tuesday and Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> September as planning days</u> in order for risk assessments and other operational services to be signed off so, <u>pupils will return on a phased basis from Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2020</u>. Priority will be given on these days to our new intake of pupils in Nursery and Reception where parents/carers and pupils will have the opportunity to meet and spend time in the class meeting the full staff. <u>Please note an individual letter with the start date for your child/ren will</u> <u>be sent next week</u>. Family siblings will be attending on the same start

dates unless Nursery or Reception intake, which will be slightly earlier.
