PHASED RETURN TO SCHOOL - CHILDREN IN NURSERY, RECEPTION, YEAR 1 & 2

As you will be aware the Minister for Education announced that schools will be reopening to children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and 2 after half term. Welsh Government issued updated operational guidance for schools earlier this week, which we have reviewed and discussed with our LA and governing body.

As we all know, we are very much still in the middle of the Coronavirus pandemic and additional measures have now been included in our school plan. These include regular testing of school staff and the requirement for all staff to wear face masks in school, including in classrooms.

Wearing a mask is now a requirement for primary school staff in situations where social distancing cannot be maintained. Parents are also required to bring pupils (one adult only) and to wear a mask when dropping off and picking up from schools to reduce community transmission.

Wearing of face coverings (primary)
