
E-Consent Intranasal Flu Vaccine session

<u>Civica Pay – payment for school meals etc</u>

On the morning of Friday 21st October, Civica Pay Education will undergo a security upgrade and improvement to its payment gateway.

From 10am to 1pm on Friday; Civica Pay Education will be unavailable for all payment related activities. Please do not attempt to log-in during this time.

If you make ad hoc payments, you will not be affected by this change other than to expect to go through additional security if you choose to save your card or subscribe to auto-top ups.

For those of you who have * saved a card to your account or * subscribed to auto-top ups, you will be required to perform a one-off security check before using your card in this way. The additional security features are all to do with the way Civica Pay hold your card holder details (i.e. credentials). Banks require this mandatory security check called 3D52 before your card details are saved.

Saved Cards

You will not be able to use your saved card(s) at the check-out without undertaking this one-time security check. Before making any further payments using a saved card, you are advised to delete all your saved cards and re-add them following the on-screen instructions, which will probably include entering your home address for the card being saved.

Auto-Top Up Subscriptions


As part of the upgrade all subscriptions have been deleted so you will be required to re-subscribe to the service. This is because the card you used to set up the auto-top up will need to be deleted and re-added as explained above. You will need to follow the steps below:

- 1. Delete-your saved card
- 2. Re-save your card undertaking the additional security checks
- 3. Re-subscribe to the auto-top up service


New Digi Hub in Garndiffaith
