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

Pupil Absence

The message should give details of the absence/illness. The Education Welfare Service have asked us to contact all parents/carers for details of illness if the reason given is feeling unwell/ill/poorly.

Registration

Doors are open for Registration at 8.40am and registration takes place in classes at 9.00am, please ensure your child is in class by 9.00am. Both gates are closed at 9.00am. Pupils will be recorded <u>as late</u> if they arrive after 9.10am. Pupils who arrive after 9.30am will be marked <u>as an unauthorised absence</u> and could be referred to the Education Welfare Officer. A recurrence of late marks throughout any week will also be referred to the Education Welfare Officer.


We are organising the shop for children to buy gifts. This will start on Monday 13th March 2023 and prices will range from £1.00- £5.00. We hope you are able to support us.
