

F1 in schools Competition Garnteg represented Wales in the UK awards in Leeds

Last weekend, a group of pupils from Year 4 represented South Wales at the UK Finals of the F1 in Schools Primary Competition in Leeds.

The competition challenges the pupils to become an F1 racing team, creating their own team brand; designing, testing and making a model race car and finally racing the model race car down a 25m track.

The two teams, The Power Ladies and Blue Waves earned the opportunity to represent South Wales after finishing 1st and 2nd at the regional event where the pupils had to create a pit display and portfolio of their work, talk to judges about their work, as well as race their model cars.

At the UK Finals, the children competed against other regional winners from all over the UK, with the finals being streamed live on the F1 YouTube channel.

We had an amazing weekend in Leeds with our two teams. It was an experience that we will never forget. Both teams truly excelled throughout the day and showed impeccable behaviour. The Power Ladies team was applauded for their exceptional research and development of their car. We are extremely proud of all the team members for their hard work, and we can't wait to compete again next year.
